ANDREW HUNT "BOLTON'S ROCK N' BLUESMAN"

Originally from Bolton, Ontario Andrew Hunt lives, works and plays music in his hometown. His instrument of choice is the guitar in which he took a liking to as a kid.

Andrew was inspired by his older brother who always played his electric guitar in his bedroom across the hallway. His brother usually had his friends over for parties and back then Andrew thought they were really cool. Andrew would often go into his brother's room and try his guitar. He recalls picking up a guitar that was tucked under his bed. It was his sister's old guitar that she use to play. It had rigid strings which he could barely press down the notes, let alone make a sound with it. Determined, he kept on working at it until he could "make the thing talk".

Both his sister and brother had an extensive record and tape collection, the likes of Black Sabbath, Ozzy Osborne, Jim Croce, Led Zeppelin and Pink Floyd to name a few. Andrew used to sift through their collection and dream of playing those tunes well. As he continued to play, it became an obsession of his. He started listening to old Cream albums, mainly the Disraeli Gears album which he was completely blown away by Eric Clapton's tone, feel and emotion.

His idols were Eric Clapton and Jimi Hendrix and he learned on his own how to replicate their music as much as he could. A turning point in his playing was when he found the music books of Jimi Hendrix's albums. He would listen to the album and study the books note for note until he had it down pat. It got to a point where people would say that his playing was good but he sounded too much like Hendrix.

Andrew use to take his guitar with him everywhere, and When he was around 15 or 16 years old, he would go to field parties with his friends and sit around singing American Pie and Hotel California. Those were some good times for him.

"A feather in his cap" as Andrew puts it, is when he took over a band and became lead guitarist/vocalist and they won the band competition at Humberview that year. He also was in another band that competed against 27 other bands and won some money and recording time.

Andrew is now focused on his growth as a musician. Vocal lessons has given him more confidence and he is now comfortable with his singing voice. He is writing music that comes from a place that he cannot describe, and beyond what he has ever written before. He would like his guitar playing to come from that same place. He recognizes how far he has come and grown as a musician. "Growth comes from truly being yourself, and playing from that as opposed to trying to imitate other people. It's all about emotions and being honest and true."
