Gordon Deppe : "The Retro thing is great. We're lucky you know, I thought it was all over but then the Retro thing started, and now there's new life to all this old stuff. It's great!"

Do you find that it is just the older generation that are into it; the ones that remember the songs?

Gordon Deppe: "No, the younger generation like us too! They love the sound of the 80's. Even though they don't know that we are actually from the 80's, they think that we are a current band that sounds like an 80's band."

So what brings you to Bolton?

Gordon Deppe: "When I don't play with the Spoons... I love to play no matter what. I have another band called the Lost Boys, and I play with these guys sometimes (Pirate Radio) and I don't really like to advertise that I'm from the Spoons. Because it's an 80's night I like to throw in a couple of Spoons songs. We're primarily a Police band tonight. The Police and the Spoons were intertwined in the 80's. We did a few shows together and Sting was very instrumental in getting us our deal with Pan Am Los Angeles and he introduced us to Nile Rodgers in New York."
