DAVID HENMAN, a founder of April Wine explores a new landscape.

As I walked downstairs to David Henman's basement to rehearse for a gig at the Archtop Cafe, it was hard not to notice the gold and platinum records hanging on the wall.

David Henman, a singer, guitarist and songwriter is originally from Nova Scotia. He was a founding member of April Wine, along with brother Ritchie, cousin Jim and surviving member, Myles Goodwyn. David was with the band from its inception in 1969 until 1973. He played on the first three albums, and one of his songs, "Drop Your Guns", was a top-forty hit. During periods of war or domestic violence, such as the Columbine school shootings, the anti-violence theme of this hit refreshes its popularity on radio and other media. In 2010, David was inducted, along with past members of April Wine, into the Juno Awards Canadian Music Hall of Fame. David's website is www.davidhenman.com

Now David lives in Bolton, where at the Archtop, he has found a kind of musical community he missed living in Toronto, Scarborough and other dense urban environments. The community showed up in force for his performance on April 25th. Both the new and older original songs he did defy classification, though they evoke Classic Rock, Country, Gospel, Maritime traditional and Latin. He moves effortlessly from genre to genre. He still loves his roots in Rock, but is now inspired by the hand-drumming of World Music and artists like Loreena McKinnitt who blend traditions like Celtic, Sufi and Near Asian.

David grew up listening to Country music and sometimes wonders why he's not in a Country band. Strong lyrics are the foundation of Country music, as they are for David's compositions. He takes the poetry seriously and revises constantly. His verbal style seems simple, but reveals subtlety, mood, atmosphere and an evolving mental picture. His themes reflect the perspective of long life experience often lacking in popular music for a younger demographic.

The Archtop crowd listened with the rapt, intimate attention I remember from the jazz clubs of years ago. The energy built to a pitch right up to the last encore, a fully-improvised piece played masterfully by David's band of old friends, seasoned musicians, who delivered in the moment. David is exploring a new landscape and moving on, with tireless creativity. Stephen Slutsky
